# CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. INSPECTION : No lot is available for inspection by post.
2. EXTENSION: Extensions for expertising will be granted on application. Any purchase made with an extension is payable in full in compliance with Condition 7. Such monies will not be made available to the vendor until the purchaser has received the certificate. The onus shall be on the purchaser to obtain such certificate within a reasonable time, and bear all costs. If the item does not receive a clear certificate, the Auctioneer will refund any expertisation fee not exceeding seventy dollars (\$70).
3. BIDDING
  - 3.1 Bidding, either absentee or in the room, will bind the bidder to these conditions of sale. Subject to any reserve price, the highest bidder shall purchase the lot: any dispute arising as to who is the highest bidder shall be determined by the Auctioneer who may offer the lot again. The Auctioneer may group, split up or withdraw lots, and transfer bids to identical lots at his discretion.
  - 3.2 The bidder shall be deemed to purchase as buyer unless prior to bidding he has given the Auctioneer a copy of a written authority to bid on behalf of another person.
  - 3.3 Where an agent purchases on behalf of an undisclosed client, such agent shall be personally liable for payment of the purchase money to the Auctioneer and for safe delivery of the lot to the said client.
  - 3.4 Vendor bids shall not be accepted.
4. BIDDING INCREMENTS: Postal bids must comply with the following steps:

Under \$300 - \$10 increases	\$1,000-\$2,000 - \$50 increases
\$300-\$500 - \$20 increases	\$2,000-\$5,000 - \$100 increases
\$500-\$1,000 - \$25 increases	

Otherwise, the regulation of bidding is at the Auctioneer's discretion.
5. ABSENTEE BIDDERS: Bids will be accepted from persons unable to attend the auction, and their bids will be treated in utmost confidence and managed as though the bidder is in the room. The Auctioneer shall not be liable for errors or omissions in executing bids. Absentee bidders, who have not seen the lots they are buying, may reject any lot with the exception of bulk or mixed lots and collections, where the description is not in accordance with that given in the catalogue. However, any such lots are only returnable within forty-eight (48) hours of receipt, and in the condition received.
6. ESTIMATES: These are conservative. Bidding will commence at a bidding increment over the second highest postal/absentee bid received prior to commencement of the auction. Where one or no bids have been received, bidding will commence at seventy percent (70%) of the lot estimate, or at reserve if above 70%.
7. PAYMENT: Lots will be at the buyer's risk from the fall of the hammer but title shall not pass until payment in full has been made of the purchase price (hammer price plus 15% buyer's premium plus GST on buyers premium for NZ buyers) and, if applicable, interest). Payment and clearance of lots by room buyers may be carried out on the day of the sale. Payment by postal/absentee bidders must be made upon receipt of invoice. Payments not received within 30 days of auction date will be subject to 2% penalty interest.
8. No GST is charged on the hammer price, but purchasers outside of New Zealand undertake that neither they or an associated person will cause the goods to be re-imported into New Zealand in substantially the same condition in which they were exported.
8. FAILURE TO PAY: If the buyer breaches Condition 7, the Auctioneer, without prejudice to any other rights available to it, shall be entitled without notice to the buyer to exercise one or more of the following rights and remedies:
  - 8.1 to terminate the contract with the buyer and any monies which the buyer has paid to the Auctioneer on account of such purchase or purchases shall be forfeited;
  - 8.2 to terminate the contract, resell the lot at any time by public auction and the buyer shall pay to the Auctioneer any resulting deficiency in the purchase price (plus interest) and insurance. Any surplus shall be paid to the vendor;
  - 8.3 to apply any monies at any time due by the Auctioneer to the buyer in payment of the purchase price (plus interest). The Auctioneer shall have a lien over any property of the buyer in the possession of the Auctioneer, in order to secure any monies due to the Auctioneer; and
  - 8.4 to proceed against the buyer for damages for breach of contract.
9. The Auctioneer reserves the right to refuse admission to any person to either viewing or the sale room, and the Auctioneer may refuse any bid.

## **Welcome to our 13th auction!**

We start with a good range of New Zealand coins, one Waitangi set and two Proof Crowns.

There are many 1935 3d, some high grade to Unc, pre-decimal single EF-UNC silver coins, plus nice mixed lots with realistic reserves.

Then a huge range of Decimal Proofs, right through to 2012, many at reserves well below issue price. NZ Gold proofs almost complete with duplicates.

Great Britain includes valuable lots from hammered to early milled, an interesting and EF+ lot of Maundy singles. A good variety of other World Coins too.

There are over 100 lots of Gold coins at realistic reserves. These range from Roman coins and George III Guineas through to modern singles and sets. Reserves for most are set below the current bullion price.

Some rare and unusual items include Trade tokens from Mears, an EF Hall/Emu mule, and a nice range of silver Ancient Rome + Greek coins in F-VF condition

The Banknote section is amazing! We have several items from the Alistair Robb Estate: An outstanding £1 Fitzroy Debenture, The 1869 £1 Union Banknote ex Griffin, sold in by us in 2004; 1840 Kororarika Unissued cheques and some 1840 Wellington Bills of Exchange etc. Probably the oldest Financial instruments in private hands.

Later there is a good range of Trading Banks, including a contemporary forgery of a 1930 National Bank £ 1.

There are many pre-decimals and decimals. The decimals include TWO noteworthy album collections.

This year we have an unusually strong offering of Militaria. There are 9 x NZ Land War medals, including 3 from the 1843-46 1<sup>st</sup> War. There are 5 x NZ WWII Groups with Memorial Crosses.

There are two important Family Groups. The best is from The Hawkesby Family which runs over three generations, beginning with Grandfather in the Royal Irish Regiment, NZ War 1865-66, his son in India and as a NZ Rifleman in WWI. The Grandson, Major G H Hawkesby served in WWII and through Gallant Action in Italy was awarded a DSO.

**The Grandfather** served in the 1865-66 NZ Wars as part of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Bn 18<sup>th</sup> Royal Irish Reg. He was also awarded an Army Long Service & Good Conduct Award.

**The Father** joined the same Regiment, and served 17 Years in the UK & India, awarded India Medal with 3 clasps 1895-8. He was retired and migrated to NZ in 1904. In 1916 he embarked as part of the NZ Rifle Brigade and saw European service. He was awarded 1914-18 War Medal and 1919 Victory Medal.

**The son**, Major George H Hawkesby 23708, served in 21 Infantry Battalion in North Africa and Italy. On 22 Sept 1944 he took part in action for which he was awarded the Distinguished Service Order. (Citation and other details available on request). He retired in 1966, and his Efficiency Decoration was the last of 6 medals awarded. The medals are displayed in a glass fronted wooden frame. There is also extensive research on each person and copies of original records.
