# CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. INSPECTION : No lot is available for inspection by post.
2. EXTENSION: Extensions for expertising will be granted on application. Any purchase made with an extension is payable in full in compliance with Condition 7. Such monies will not be made available to the vendor until the purchaser has received the certificate. The onus shall be on the purchaser to obtain such certificate within a reasonable time, and bear all costs. If the item does not receive a clear certificate, the Auctioneer will refund any expertisation fee not exceeding seventy dollars (\$70).
3. BIDDING
  - 3.1 Bidding, either absentee or in the room, will bind the bidder to these conditions of sale. Subject to any reserve price, the highest bidder shall purchase the lot: any dispute arising as to who is the highest bidder shall be determined by the Auctioneer who may offer the lot again. The Auctioneer may group, split up, or withdraw lots, and transfer bids to identical lots at his discretion.
  - 3.2 The bidder shall be deemed to purchase as buyer unless prior to bidding he has given the Auctioneer a copy of a written authority to bid on behalf of another person.
  - 3.3 Where an agent purchases on behalf of an undisclosed client, such agent shall be personally liable for payment of the purchase money to the Auctioneer and for safe delivery of the lot to the said client.
  - 3.4 Vendor bids shall not be accepted.
4. BIDDING INCREMENTS: Postal bids must comply with the following steps:

Under \$300 - \$10 increases	\$1,000-\$2,000 - \$50 increases
\$300-\$500 - \$20 increases	\$2,000-\$5,000 - \$100 increases
\$500-\$1,000 - \$25 increases	

Otherwise, the regulation of bidding is at the Auctioneer's discretion.
5. ABSENTEE BIDDERS: Bids will be accepted from persons unable to attend the auction, and their bids will be treated in utmost confidence and managed as though the bidder is in the room. The Auctioneer shall not be liable for errors or omissions in executing bids. Absentee bidders, who have not seen the lots they are buying, may reject any lot with the exception of bulk or mixed lots and collections, where the description is not in accordance with that given in the catalogue. However, any such lots are only returnable within forty-eight (48) hours of receipt, and in the condition received.
6. ESTIMATES: These are conservative. Bidding will commence at a bidding increment over the second highest postal/absentee bid received prior to commencement of the auction. Where one or no bids have been received, bidding will commence at seventy percent (70%) of the lot estimate, or at reserve if above 70%.
7. PAYMENT: Lots will be at the buyer's risk from the fall of the hammer, but title shall not pass until payment in full has been made of the purchase price (hammer price plus 15% buyer's premium (plus GST on buyers premium for NZ buyers) and, if applicable, interest). Payment and clearance of lots by room buyers may be carried out on the day of the sale. Payment by postal/absentee bidders must be made upon receipt of invoice. Payments not received within 30 days of auction date will be subject to 2% penalty interest.
8. No GST is charged on the hammer price, but purchasers outside of New Zealand undertake that neither they or an associated person will cause the goods to be re-imported into New Zealand in substantially the same condition in which they were exported.
9. FAILURE TO PAY: If the buyer breaches Condition 7, the Auctioneer, without prejudice to any other rights available to it, shall be entitled without notice to the buyer to exercise one or more of the following rights and remedies:-
  - 9.1 to terminate the contract with the buyer and any monies which the buyer has paid to the Auctioneer on account of such purchase or purchases shall be forfeited;
  - 9.2 to terminate the contract, resell the lot at any time by public auction and the buyer shall pay to the Auctioneer any resulting deficiency in the purchase price (plus interest) and insurance. Any surplus shall be paid to the vendor;
  - 9.3 to apply any monies at any time due by the Auctioneer to the buyer in payment of the purchase price (plus interest). The Auctioneer shall have a lien over any property of the buyer in the possession of the Auctioneer, in order to secure any monies due to the Auctioneer; and
  - 9.4 to proceed against the buyer for damages for breach of contract.

# Mowbray International Numismatic Auction #16

## 14th October 2016

Welcome to this exciting catalogue with 708 lots totalling \$NZ403,650. This is Mowbray's second highest value offering ever. Read on to discover the highlights.

World, British and New Zealand coins provide good opportunities for collectors on all budgets and especially for silver, including bulk collections. Unusual opportunities include nineteen Bolivian 17th Century rough cob 8 reales – the classic “pirate treasure” coin, scarce South African 1893 dated coins and BU New Zealand 1956 strapless Threepences. The two Waitangi Crowns are our best for some time while the Waitangi Proof Set leads a comprehensive offering of recent New Zealand proof coins.

This is the first time Mowbrays have offered the Solomon Islands mule with NZ \$5 of 2000 and the recently discovered 2004 10 cent/\$1 mule. Joseph Moore's rare New Zealand 1879 pattern penny leads a selection of nineteenth century tradesmen's tokens.

Gold is once again an outstanding feature of this auction with 213 gold coins and 3 gold medals. There are plenty of opportunities for those interested in bullion to acquire gold at realistic market prices, especially sovereigns with a wide date range from the UK and a selection from Australia and South Africa. Platinum coins from New Zealand and the world provide further bullion interest.

The range of gold is our most diverse ever, starting from a Stater of Philip II of Macedonia (359 to 336 BC) and another of Thracian Kings from 54 BC. The select group from Ancient Rome's first century AD Emperors includes one aureus each from Vespasian and Trajan and the very rare aureus estimated at \$15,000 of Julia Titi, niece and mistress of Domitian. Five Byzantine pieces from the 11th Century AD, including one described as “one of the most beautiful of Byzantine coins” are followed by British hammered gold from Henry VII to Charles I. A great range of British Half and Full Guineas and Sovereigns follows, culminating in the 1989 Gold sovereign set up to 5 Pounds.

World gold is strongest in British Commonwealth countries, accompanied by coins from the heyday of the gold standard from the USA and Europe and Chilean and South African bullion.

An extensive range of New Zealand gold includes an infrequently seen 2012 Premium Hobbit gold set, the sought after 2004 Pukaki coin and rare 2007 Scouting Anniversary coin. It contains the most recent 2016 Rio Olympics Coin – a great chance to celebrate New Zealand's most successful Olympics ever!

The best medallic story is the large 1882 gold medal presented by Queen Victoria to a top trainee of the British maritime training facility, “HMS Worcester”, Francis Baring Walsh, who later migrated to New Zealand to become manager of a sheep station.

Masonic and German beer festival medals might also appeal. Other medals provide a microcosm of New Zealand's past – Wars from the 1860's to World War II, cultural life from bagpipes and dance to cows, sports and celebrations such as the 1940 centennial.

Also historically significant are cheques signed by Arthur Wakefield in 1842 in the earliest days of settlement and from the failed Colonial Bank. Don't overlook Sutherland's "Numismatic History of New Zealand" if you want a copy.

Banknotes end the catalogue with by far our best offerings from New Zealand in recent years. The highest estimate prize goes to the aVF Lefeaux 50 pounds at \$NZ 18,000. We also have another of the approximately 80 that Alistair Robb thought exist in VG at \$5000. New to market and rare according to Alistair is the Z prefix Bank of Australasia One Pound of 1 July 1924, with just two earlier thought to be in private hands.

Wilson and Hanna 50 pounds, higher grade NZ decimals, a \$100 Fleming run of eight, printing errors and scarce Wilks stars add spice to the banknotes.

World banknotes offer a good selection of UNC and Specimen higher values. An album of Japanese banknotes, mostly high grade and wartime, provides an unusual opportunity, with a rare Malayan 1945 ND \$1000 in EF. And for the collector who hasn't acquired enough "NZ" banknotes, there's a nice Nouveaux Zaire 1990's specimen set to end the catalogue!

Many people have contributed to this catalogue. I particularly wish to thank Nicola Bowden, Arna Dal Din, Maree Malin, Keren Malin, Lyndell Fitzgibbon, Jan McDonald and John Mowbray for their contributions along with our many New Zealand and international vendors.
